ORDER AUTHORIZING SUIT, EXPENSES AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS

On this the 21 day of August 20____, at a regular meeting of the Commissioner Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, sitting as the governing body of Fort Bend County, Texas, upon motion of the Commissioner Meyers, seconded by Commissioner Prestage, duly put and carried;

IT IS ORDERED THAT COUNTY ATTORNEY BRIDGETTE SMITH-LAWSON be authorized to file a lawsuit and take any other steps that she deems be necessary or desirable on Fort Bend County's behalf against All In One Drilling and any other party whomsoever to recover and collect the amount of \$13,809.10, plus attorney fees and court costs, for damages incurred to Fort Bend County Conduit Signal located at the intersection of Old Richmond Rd. and W. Bellfort, on or about September 8, 2023, plus whatever other relief may be available to Fort Bend County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT BRIDGETTE SMITH-LAWSON, County Attorney of Fort Bend County, Texas is hereby authorized to incur initial litigation expenses in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.00. It is ORDERED to approve transfer in the amount of \$5,000.00 from Non-Departmental Fees to County Attorney Fees as listed on Auditor's form dated August 8, 2024 to allocate funds for litigation expenses.
