WHEREAS, Fort Bend County wishes to amend the REVISED ORDER CREATING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR NONCONSENT TOWING AND STORAGE SERVICES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF FORT BEND COUNTY for the County of Fort Bend, Texas, as follows:

Article III Tow Truck Operator ID Permits, Section B Permit Applications, Sub-section 2 shall be amended as shown with strikethrough to denote text to be deleted and <u>underline</u> to denote text to be added in the following language:

- 2. Completed applications must be filed at the Sheriff's Office or other designated location. A completed application must be accompanied by the following documentation:
 - a. A copy of the applicant's valid Texas commercial driving driver's license; or
 - b. A copy of the applicant's valid Texas commercial driver's license when, as authorized by the Texas Transportation Code Section 522.041, and as amended, the Tow Truck Operator will be:
 - (i) operating tows where the gross combination weight rating of the tow is 26,001 lbs. or more, and the gross vehicle weight rating of the towed vehicle or vehicles exceeds 10,000 lbs., or
 - (ii) operating tows where the gross vehicle weight rating of the Tow Truck is 26,001 lbs. or more;

b. A color passport photo;

- c. A color passport photo of the applicant;
- c. The application fee set forth in Section V of these Rules.
