AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

This Amendment (“Amendment”) is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County, Texas (“County”), a political subdivision of the state of Texas, and RPS Infrastructure, Inc. (“Consultant”), a Texas company. County and Consultant may be referred to individually as a “Party” or collectively as the “Parties.”

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into that certain agreement on or about January 24, 2023 (the “Agreement”) for the development of a Comprehensive Plan for the Old Fresno area under Mobility Bond Project No. 20227x pursuant to SOQ 14-025; and

WHEREAS, by execution of this Amendment, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement to provide for additional services and to increase the total Maximum Compensation for the completion of such services as set forth therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the Parties do mutually agree that the Agreement between the Parties is hereby amended as follows:

1. **Compensation.** County shall pay Consultant an additional One Hundred Forty Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Three and 00/100 Dollars (\$140,493.00) for the performance and completion of additional services as described in Consultant's Proposal dated June 21, 2024 (the "Services") attached hereto as "Exhibit A-1" and incorporated by reference for all intents and purposes.
2. **Limit of Appropriation.** Consultant understands and agrees that the Maximum Compensation payable to Consultant for Services rendered under this Agreement is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed Six Hundred Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen and 50/100 Dollars (\$606,815.50) authorized as follows:

\$466,322.50 under the Agreement; and
\$140,493.00 under this Amendment.

In no event shall the amount paid by County under this Agreement exceed the Maximum Compensation without a County approved change order. Consultant clearly understands and agrees, such understanding and agreement being of the absolute essence of this Agreement, that County shall have available the total maximum sum of Six Hundred Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen and 50/100 Dollars (\$606,815.50) specifically allocated to fully discharge any and all liabilities County may incur under the Agreement.

Consultant does further understand and agree, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of the Agreement, that the total Maximum Compensation that Consultant may become entitled to and the total maximum sum that County may become liable to pay to Consultant under the Agreement shall not under any conditions, circumstances, or interpretations thereof exceed Six Hundred Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen and 50/100 Dollars (\$606,815.50).

3. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of the Agreement.
4. **Human Trafficking.** BY ACCEPTANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT, CONSULTANT ACKNOWLEDGES THAT FORT BEND COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.
5. **Modifications and Conflict.** Except as modified herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and has not been otherwise modified or amended. If there is a conflict among documents that make up the Agreement, this Amendment shall prevail with regard to the conflict.

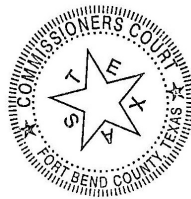
