Requirements for Agencies Who Place Surveillance Cameras on CEHE Property

Federal, state and local law enforcement or public safety agencies which place surveillance cameras on the poles and equipment owned by Center Point Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CEHE), must comply with the following requirements:

- 1. The agency will have only qualified employees or contractors who are trained in accordance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards, 29 CFR sec. 1910.269(a)(2) install the cameras on CEHE's poles and equipment.
- 2. If a camera is installed on a pole or other CEHE equipment that is not in the public right of way, the agency will have a warrant that permits the agency to install the camera on that pole or piece of equipment.
- 3. The agency will notify CEHE's Corporate Security Department of the location(s) of the camera installations.
- 4. The agency assumes the maximum risk and liability allowed by law associated with the placing of surveillance cameras on CEHE's poles and equipment and is responsible for having the appropriate insurance coverage.
- 5. The agency will remove the camera once the need for the surveillance no longer exists.
- 6. The agency will not make any repairs or alterations to CEHE's equipment.
