## Emergency Rental Assistance Program Summary





## Emergency Rental Assistance Updates

The Fort Bend County Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERA2) final phase launched on **November 25, 2024.** It continues to provide eligible low-income households in Fort Bend County with up to \$2,000 per month in rental assistance and \$500 per month for utilities. All program funds must be fully expended by **September 30, 2025.** 



#### **Program Highlights**

- To date, the program has served 153 Fort Bend County households.
- Approximately 1,400 tenant applications for rental assistance have been submitted and reviewed.
- Over **240 landlords and property managers** have enrolled in the program.
- Of those enrolled, about 42% are eligible landlords actively participating.
- The program utilizes the TAAG software for applicant and landlord case management and document retention.



#### **Outreach Efforts:**

- In-person visits to apartment complexes to promote program participation
- Engaged property managers, offering clear guidance on program requirements.
- Partnered with the county judge's office to host an information session for landlords.



## Strategy to reach remaining households:

- Conduct door-to-door outreach and flyer drops.
- Reconnect with landlords who previously participated or showed interest.
- Offer landlord info sessions to clarify terms and encourage participation.
