Duly put and unanimously carried (5-0), it is ordered to approve Item 3, as presented.

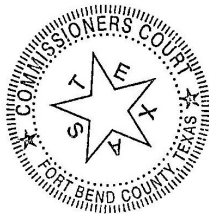

It was originally proposed as a 20,000 sq ft facility and 4,000 sq ft is added as a clinic and partnership with Access Health. We have now received support from Congresswoman Fletcher for congressional funding. This is to move from our general obligation bond debt to use CAD 2 funds.
