Fort Bend County invites all citizens to review and comment on the following proposed amendments:

1. FY 2016 & FY 2017 Housing Buyout Guidelines – Increase the maximum purchase price limit for eligible properties to \$600,000. If approved, the change will apply to current and future applicants. The Housing Buyout Program assists eligible property owners whose homes were damaged by flooding or other qualifying disasters by purchasing properties at pre-disaster fair market value and converting the land to permanent open space use.
2. Contract #18-523-000-B264 and Housing Assistance Program Guidelines – Extend the contract end date to November 1, 2027, and update construction standards and square footage thresholds to reflect current residential building norms in Fort Bend County.
