



In no event shall the amount paid by County under the Agreement exceed the Maximum Compensation without a County approved change order. CONTRACTOR clearly understands and agrees, such understanding and agreement being of the absolute essence of this Agreement, as amended, that County shall have available the total maximum sum of \$759,853.58 specifically allocated to fully discharge any and all liabilities County may incur under the Agreement, as amended.

CONTRACTOR does further understand and agree, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of the Agreement, as amended, that the total Maximum Compensation that CONTRACTOR may become entitled to and the total maximum sum that County may become liable to pay to CONTRACTOR under the Agreement shall not under any conditions, circumstances, or interpretations thereof exceed \$759,853.58.

3. **Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts.** The contents of this Section are required by Texas law and are included by County regardless of content for purposes of Sections 2252.152, 2271.002, and 2274.002, Texas Government Code, as amended, CONTRACTOR hereby verifies that CONTRACTOR and any parent company, wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, and affiliate:
  - A. Unless affirmatively declared by the United States government to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan or Iran or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization, is not identified on a list prepared and maintained by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.
  - B. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, CONTRACTOR does not boycott Israel and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott Israel during the term of such contracts. "Boycott Israel" has the meaning provided in § 808.001 of the Texas Government Code.
  - C. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, CONTRACTOR does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in § 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
  - D. If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, CONTRACTOR does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the

meaning provided in §2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. “Firearm entity” and “firearm trade association” have the meanings provided in §2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.

4. **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of the Agreement, as amended.
5. **Human Trafficking.** BY ACCEPTANCE OF THIS THIRD AMENDMENT, CONTRACTOR ACKNOWLEDGES THAT FORT BEND COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.
6. **Modifications and Conflict.** Except as modified herein, the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and has not been otherwise modified or amended. If there is a conflict among documents that make up the Agreement, this Third Amendment shall prevail with regard to the conflict.
7. **Certification.** By his or her signature below, each signatory individual certifies that he or she is the properly authorized person or officer of the applicable Party hereto and has the requisite authority necessary to execute this Third Amendment on behalf of such Party, and each Party hereby certifies to the other that it has obtained the appropriate approvals or authorizations from its governing body as required by law.

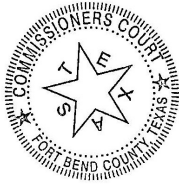

Enclosed are Huitt-Zollars, Inc.'s proposed budget, manpower and direct expense breakdown and scope of services for the additional work requested by PMC LJA Inc.

1. Verify existing information since the original survey is more than 6 years old. Visit Site and update the existing conditions and relocated utilities as needed to keep the plans and design up to date.
2. Update Traffic Signal Design to the latest standards and latest specifications.
3. Replace old standard details with new standard details.
4. Update Cost Estimate item quantities and unit prices.
5. Update Project Manual with latest pay items, specifications and bid form based on the latest Harris County and TxDOT Specifications.
6. Address any final set of comments received from FBCTRA, Fort Bend County or PMC/LJA in the plan set before preparing the Bid Documents.
7. Provide Bidding Services. Prepare Bid Documents for Fort Bend County. Answer bidding questions, issue addendums if needed and analyze bid tabs. Attend Pre-Bid meeting and attend Bid Opening at Fort Bend County.
8. Update Utilities and Provide Utility Coordination services based on the latest changes.
9. Provide Construction Administration services described below:
  - a. Attend Pre-construction meeting.
  - b. Attend bi-weekly progress meetings.
  - c. Reviewing submittals.
  - d. Answering RFI's.
  - e. Participate in Substantial Walk Thru
  - f. Prepare record drawings from as-built drawings (to be provided by the contractor).
10. The Bid & Construction Phase would be billed as per time and materials spent.

### Additional Optional Scope of Work

As part of Parcel 1 acquisition negotiations, it is possible that the private property owner of Parcel 1 or the Homeowners Association may ask Fort Bend County to provide landscaping adjacent to Parcel 1 acquisition because of the loss of green space due to roadway widening.

In the event that the HOA wants additional tree or shrub planting in this location, Huitt-Zollars will provide 1 to 2 construction plan sheets at maximum 1" = 20'-0" scale, and a planting detail sheet. Planting plan scope shall be limited to the Northeast corner from Mason Road, extending approximately 325' southeast to the property line of the multi-family property. Huitt-Zollars to provide planting specifications, submittal review and RFI review services for this landscaping area.

This work will only be performed if requested by Fort Bend County or LJA.
