# Proclamation





- WHEREAS,** in February 2025, the Fort Bend County Library system's technology infrastructure was fully compromised, bringing critical library services to a halt and impacting residents across the County; and
- WHEREAS,** the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court swiftly directed the County Information Technology Department to lead the recovery and complete rebuild of the Library's technology environment; and
- WHEREAS,** over a six-month period, twenty-six full-time IT professionals and five dedicated contractors worked with unwavering commitment, balancing the demands of the rebuild while continuing progress on more than 67 scheduled County IT projects; and
- WHEREAS,** their extraordinary efforts included on-site technical support at every library branch, and the delivery of new, resilient technology systems for both staff and the public; and
- WHEREAS,** this accomplishment stands as a powerful example of IT's teamwork, innovation, and dedication to public service, restoring safe and modern library access for the residents of Fort Bend County and reinforcing the County's commitment to excellence in service delivery




