ORDER OF COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS
ADOPTING NEW VOTING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, on August 29, 2025, Texas Governor Greg Abbot signed into law HB 4 of the Second Special Session of the 89th Texas Legislature, modifying and establishing Congressional District Boundaries in Fort Bend County; and

WHEREAS, on October 13, 2025, the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court approved changes to the Commissioner and Justice of the Peace boundaries within Fort Bend County; and

WHEREAS, Section 42.005 of the Texas Election code mandates that a county election precinct may not contain territory from more than one Commissioners Precinct, Justice Precinct, Congressional District, State Representative District, State Senatorial District, or State Board of Education District, and

WHEREAS, after convening a duly noticed public hearing on November 6, 2025, for the purpose of presenting a proposed new precinct map and receiving public comments, the Court has determined to adopt the map in Exhibit 1.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED.

1. That the Court adopts the new precinct map attached hereto as Exhibit 1, establishing voting precinct boundaries.
2. That the new precinct boundaries shall take effect January 1, 2026.
3. That the County Clerk is directed to file this Order with attachments in the official records of the Court and to provide a certified copy to the Elections Administrator and Voter Registrar within seven (7) day of adoption.

4. That the Fort Bend County Elections Administrator is directed to implement the new precinct boundaries, update voter registration records accordingly, provide all required notices to affected voters and notify the Secretary of State of changes to voting precincts in compliance with the Texas Election Code.

5. That notice of this Order and the new precinct boundaries shall be published one a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in Fort Bend County and posted on the County's official websites as required by law.



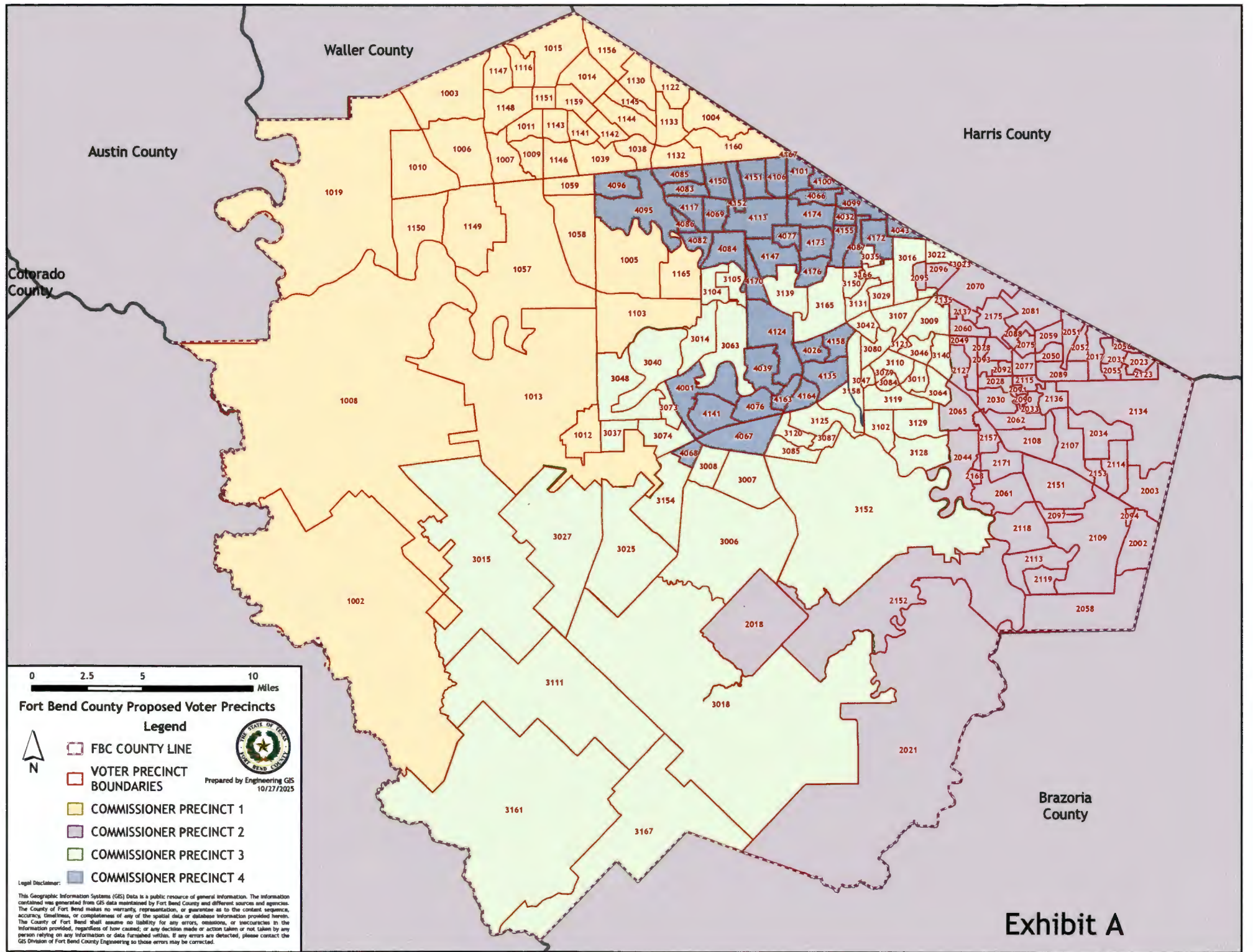
