Weekend and Holiday Magstration Policy

Description: Pursuant to **Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Article 17.028**

Magstration within 48 hours of the arrest date is statutorily required for processing all arrested individuals (felony and misdemeanor). There is an average of 116 days per year that fall on weekends or holidays that require supplemental coverage to ensure statutory compliance. The 11th Administrative Judicial Region Judge assigns visiting judges to serve in this capacity. The magstration process averages between 4 and 6 hours per day. The State currently provides funds to cover a portion of the cost of this supplemental service. The County must fund any amount not paid by the State.

Rate:

The magstration daily rate shall be 65% of the daily rate of a District Judge serving in Fort Bend County. The District Judge daily rate calculation includes the State salary (currently \$175,000) and the County supplement including Juvenile Board pay (currently \$25,000). The magstration daily rate calculation effective October 1, 2025 is:

$\$200,000 / 253 \text{ (work days)} = \$790.51 \times 50\% = \$395.26$ – Amount paid by the State Comptroller directly to the judge.

The **County Supplements** the difference between 50% of the District Judges Pay and 65% which = \$118.57 per day paid through Payroll.

The State will fund 50% of the judge's salary but it is the responsibility of the County to fund the supplement, mileage and other related expenses for the judge. In the event that the State no longer has funds available then it becomes the responsibility of the County to fund the entire cost of the visiting judge until funding is available by the State.


Process:

The invoice transmittal detailing the dates of service shall be approved by the Courts Administrator for the County and submitted to the Payroll division within the County Treasurer's Office for processing within 20 business days from the date of magstration. The amount of compensation will be calculated as follows:



Budget:

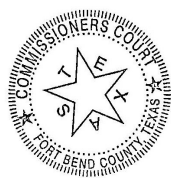
The budget shall be funded within the Courts Administration-~~Indigent Defense~~ temporary part-time account (100555104-61100) and payroll taxes account (100555104-62000). No other benefits are included in the compensation for magstration service. The County budget shall be set at the gross amount of compensation and payroll taxes less estimated State funding.
