**AGREEMENT FOR HIGH DEMAND BOOKS FOR FORT BEND COUNTY LIBRARY** (Pursuant to  
 Texas State Contract 715-M2)

This Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County, Texas ("County"), a political subdivision of the state of Texas, and Brodart Co. ("Brodart"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas. County and Brodart may be referred to individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, County desires for Brodart to provide high demand books to the Fort Bend County Library Department (the "Services") pursuant to Texas State Contract 715-M2; and

WHEREAS, Brodart represents that it is qualified and desires to perform such Services for County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the Parties do mutually agree as follows:

1.    **Purpose.** The purpose of this Agreement is to outline the obligations related to Brodart providing Services to the County pursuant to Texas State Contract 715-M2.
2.    **Recitals.** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Agreement.
3.    **Incorporated Documents.** The Exhibits listed below are a part of this Agreement and are incorporated by reference as if fully reproduced herein and constitute promised performance by Brodart in accordance with the terms of this Agreement. References to the terms "Agreement" in this Agreement shall include references to all exhibits attached hereto.
  - (a)    Brodart's Pricing Proposal, dated December 22, 2025 attached hereto as "Exhibit A."
  - (b)    Contract Item List attached hereto as "Exhibit B."
4.    **Scope of Work.**
  - (a)    Subject to this Agreement, Brodart shall provide Services in accordance with the terms and provisions of the attached Exhibits A and B.

- (b) Any revisions made to the Scope of Work, including any requests for additional work to be performed, shall not proceed without the express written consent of County. Such revisions or additional work shall be provided in a written amendment to this Agreement and executed by both Parties before commencement.
5. **Term of Agreement.** The Term of this Agreement is effective upon execution of both Parties, and shall expire no later than September 30, 2026, unless terminated sooner pursuant to this Agreement. This Agreement will not automatically renew. However, the Parties may agree to renew this Agreement for additional one-year extensions. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement may not be renewed for more than four one-year extensions.
6. **Compensation and Payment Terms.**
- (a) Brodart's fees for the Services shall be calculated at the rate(s) set forth in Brodart's Proposal attached hereto as Exhibit A. The Maximum Compensation to Brodart for the Services performed under this Agreement is Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$313,500.00). In no event shall the amount paid by County to Brodart under this Agreement exceed said Maximum Compensation without an approved change order.
  - (b) Brodart understands and agrees that the Maximum Compensation stated is an all-inclusive amount and no additional fee, cost or reimbursed expense shall be added whatsoever to the fees stated in Brodart's Proposal.
  - (c) All performance of the Scope of Work by Brodart, including any changes in the Scope of Work and revision of work satisfactorily performed, will be performed only when approved in advance and authorized by County.
  - (d) Payment shall be made by County within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice(s). Brodart may submit invoice(s) electronically in a form acceptable to County via: [apauditor@fortbendcountytexas.gov](mailto:apauditor@fortbendcountytexas.gov). If County disputes charges related to any invoice submitted by Brodart, County shall notify Brodart no later than twenty-one (21) days after the date County receives the invoice(s). If County does not dispute the invoice, then County shall pay each such approved invoice within thirty (30) calendar days.
7. **Limit of Appropriation.** Brodart understands and agrees that the Maximum Compensation for the performance of the Services within the Scope of Work described in Section 4 above is Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$313,500.00). In no event shall the amount paid by County under this Agreement exceed the Maximum Compensation without a County approved change order. Brodart clearly understands and agrees, such understanding and agreement being of the absolute

essence of this Agreement, that County shall have available the total maximum sum of Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$313,500.00) specifically allocated to fully discharge any and all liabilities County may incur under this Agreement. Brodart does further understand and agree, said understanding and agreement also being of the absolute essence of this Agreement, that the total Maximum Compensation that Brodart may become entitled to and the total maximum sum that County may become liable to pay to Brodart under this Agreement shall not under any conditions, circumstances, or interpretations thereof exceed Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$313,500.00).

8. **Non-appropriation.** Brodart understands and agrees that in the event no funds or insufficient funds are appropriated by the County under this Agreement, County shall immediately notify Brodart in writing of such occurrence and the Agreement shall thereafter terminate and be null and void on the last day of the fiscal period for which appropriations were received or made without penalty, liability or expense to the County. In no event shall said termination of this Agreement or County's failure to appropriate said funds be deemed a breach or default of this Agreement or create a debt by County in any amount(s) in excess of those previously funded.
  
9. **Taxes.** County is a body corporate and politic under the laws of the state of Texas and as such, is exempt from sales and use taxes. County shall furnish evidence of its tax-exempt status upon written request by Brodart.
  
10. **Insurance.**
  - (a) Prior to commencement of the Services, Brodart shall furnish County with properly executed certificates of insurance which shall evidence all insurance required and provide that such insurance shall not be canceled, except on 30 days' prior written notice to County. Brodart shall provide certified copies of insurance endorsements and/or policies if requested by County. Brodart shall maintain such insurance coverage from the time the Services commence until the Services are completed and shall provide replacement certificates, policies and/or endorsements for any such insurance expiring prior to completion of Services. Brodart shall obtain such insurance written on an Occurrence form from such companies having Best's rating of A/VII or better, licensed or approved to transact business in the State of Texas, and shall obtain such insurance of the following types and minimum limits:
    - (1) Workers Compensation in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. Substitutes to genuine Workers' Compensation Insurance will not be allowed.

- (2) Employers' Liability insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per injury by accident, \$1,000,000 per injury by disease, and \$1,000,000 per bodily injury by disease.
  - (3) Commercial general liability insurance with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$2,000,000 in the annual aggregate. Policy shall cover liability for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage and products/completed operations arising out of the business operations of the policyholder.
  - (4) Business Automobile Liability coverage with a combined Bodily Injury/Property Damage limit of not less than \$1,000,000 each accident. The policy shall cover liability arising from the operation of licensed vehicles by policy holder.
  - (5) Garage-keepers liability insurance with limits of not less than \$400,000 if stored on Brodart's property.
- (b) County and the members of Commissioners Court shall be named as additional insured to all required coverage except for Workers' Compensation and Professional Liability (if required). All Liability policies written on behalf of Brodart shall contain a waiver of subrogation in favor of County and the members of Commissioners Court.
  - (c) If required coverage is written on a claims-made basis, Brodart warrants that any retroactive date applicable to coverage under the policy precedes the effective date of the Agreement and that continuous coverage will be maintained or an extended discovery period will be exercised for a period of 2 years beginning from the time the work under this Agreement is completed.
  - (d) Brodart shall not commence any Services under this Agreement until it has obtained the insurance required herein and certificates of such insurance have been filed with and approved by County.
  - (e) No cancellation of or changes to the certificates, or the policies, may be made without thirty (30) days prior, written notification to County.
  - (f) Approval of the insurance by County shall not relieve or decrease the liability of Brodart.

11. **Indemnity.** Brodart shall save harmless County from and against all claims, liability, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising from activities of Brodart, its agents, servants or employees, performed under this agreement that result from the

negligent act, error, or omission of Brodart or any of Brodart's agents, servants or employees.

- (a) Brodart shall timely report all such matters to Fort Bend County and shall, upon the receipt of any such claim, demand, suit, action, proceeding, lien or judgment, not later than the fifteenth day of each month; provide Fort Bend County with a written report on each such matter, setting forth the status of each matter, the schedule or planned proceedings with respect to each matter and the cooperation or assistance, if any, of Fort Bend County required by Brodart in the defense of each matter.
- (b) Brodart's duty to defend, indemnify and hold Fort Bend County harmless shall be absolute. It shall not abate or end by reason of the expiration or termination of any contract unless otherwise agreed by Fort Bend County in writing. The provisions of this section shall survive the termination of the contract and shall remain in full force and effect with respect to all such matters no matter when they arise.
- (c) In the event of any dispute between the parties as to whether a claim, demand, suit, action, proceeding, lien or judgment appears to have been caused by or appears to have arisen out of or in connection with acts or omissions of Brodart, Brodart shall nevertheless fully defend such claim, demand, suit, action, proceeding, lien or judgment until and unless there is a determination by a court of competent jurisdiction that the acts and omissions of Brodart are not at issue in the matter.
- (d) Brodart's indemnification shall cover, and Brodart agrees to indemnify County, in the event County is found to have been negligent for having selected Brodart to perform Services described in this Agreement.
- (e) The provision by Brodart of insurance shall not limit the liability of Brodart under this Agreement.
- (f) Brodart shall cause all trade contractors and any other contractor who may have a contract to perform Services in the area where work will be performed under this Agreement, to agree to indemnify County and to hold it harmless from all claims for bodily injury and property damage that arise may from said Brodart's operations. Such provisions shall be in form satisfactory to Fort Bend County.
- (g) Loss Deduction Clause - Fort Bend County shall be exempt from, and in no way liable for, any sums of money which may represent a deductible in any insurance policy. The payment of deductibles shall be the sole responsibility of Brodart and/or trade contractor providing such insurance.

12. **Public Information Act and Open Meetings Act.** Brodart expressly acknowledges and agrees that County is a public entity and as such, is subject to the provisions of the Texas

Public Information Act under Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code. In no event shall County be liable to Brodart for release of information pursuant to Chapter 552 of the Texas Government Code or any other provision of law. Except to the extent required by law or as directed by the Texas Attorney General, County agrees to maintain the confidentiality of information provided by Brodart expressly marked as proprietary or confidential. County shall not be liable to Brodart for any disclosure of any proprietary or confidential information if such information is disclosed under Texas law or at the direction of the Texas Attorney General. Brodart further acknowledges and agrees that the terms and conditions of this Agreement are not proprietary or confidential information.

Brodart expressly acknowledges that County is subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act, TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. §§ 551.001 *et seq.*, as amended, and notwithstanding any provision in the Agreement to the contrary, County will comply with the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act in relation to this Agreement.

13. **Compliance with Laws.** Brodart shall comply with all federal, state, and local laws, statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, and the decrees of any courts or administrative bodies or tribunals in any matter affecting the performance of this Agreement, including, without limitation, Worker's Compensation laws, minimum and maximum salary and wage statutes and regulations, licensing laws and regulations. Brodart in providing all Services hereunder, further agrees to abide by the provisions of any applicable Federal or State Data Privacy Act. Brodart understands and agrees that nothing in this Agreement will be construed to waive the requirements of any record retention laws applicable to County.
14. **Independent Contractor.** In the performance of work or Services hereunder, Brodart shall be deemed an independent Contractor, and any of its agents, employees, officers, or volunteers performing work required hereunder shall be deemed solely as employees of Brodart. Brodart and its agents, employees, officers, or volunteers shall not, by performing work pursuant to this Agreement, be deemed to be employees, agents, or servants of County and shall not be entitled to any of the privileges or benefits of County employment.
15. **Use of Customer Name.** Brodart may use County's name without County's prior written consent only in Brodart's customer lists. Any other use of County's name by Brodart must have the prior written consent of County.
16. **Personnel.** Brodart represents that it presently has, or is able to obtain adequate qualified personnel in its employment for the timely performance of the Services required under this Agreement and that Brodart shall furnish and maintain, at its own expense, adequate and sufficient personnel, in the opinion of County, to perform the Services when and as required and without delays.

All employees of Brodart shall have such knowledge and experience as will enable them to perform the duties assigned to them. Any employee of Brodart or agent of Brodart who, in County's opinion, is incompetent or by his conduct become detrimental to providing work or Services for the County pursuant to this Agreement, shall, upon request of County, immediately be removed from association with the Services.

When performing any work or Services on-site at County's facilities, Brodart shall comply with, and will require that all Brodart's Personnel comply with, all applicable rules, regulations and known policies of County that are communicated to Brodart in writing, including security procedures concerning systems and data and remote access thereto, building security procedures, including the restriction of access by County to certain areas of its premises or systems for security reasons, and general health and safety practices and procedures.

17. **Inspection of Books and Records.** Brodart shall permit County, or any duly authorized agent of County, to inspect and examine the books and records of Brodart for the purpose of verifying the amount of work performed under the Scope of Work and for verifying compliance with the terms of this Agreement. County's right to inspect such books and records shall survive the termination of this Agreement for a period of five (4) years.

18. **Termination.**

(a) **Termination for Convenience.** County may terminate this Agreement at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice.

(b) **Termination for Default.** County may terminate the whole or any part of this Agreement for cause in the following circumstances:

(1). If Brodart fails to timely perform Services pursuant to this Agreement or any extension thereof granted by the County in writing; or

(2). If Brodart materially breaches any of the covenants or terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement or fails to perform any of the other provisions of this Agreement or so fails to make progress as to endanger performance of this Agreement in accordance with its terms, and in any of these circumstances does not cure such breach or failure to County's reasonable satisfaction within a period of ten (10) calendar days after receipt of notice from County specifying such breach or failure.

(c) If, after termination, it is determined for any reason whatsoever that Brodart was not in default, or that the default was excusable, the rights and obligations of the Parties shall be the same as if the termination had been issued for the convenience of the County in accordance with § 18(a) above.

- (d) Upon termination of this Agreement, County shall compensate Brodart in accordance with § 6, above, for those Services which were provided under this Agreement prior to its termination and which have not been previously invoiced to County. Brodart's final invoice for said Services will be presented to and paid by County in the same manner set forth in § 6 above.
- (e) If County terminates this Agreement as provided in this Section, no fees of any type, other than fees due and payable at the Termination Date, shall thereafter be paid to Brodart. If County terminates this Agreement prior to the termination date, County shall not be subject to any early termination fee or other penalty.
- (f) Upon termination of this Agreement for any reason, if Brodart has any property in its possession belonging to County, Brodart will account for the same, and dispose of it in the manner the County directs.

19. **Force Majeure.** Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, neither Party shall liable to the other for any delay or inability to carry out its obligations under this Agreement if such delay or inability is the result of a Force Majeure Event. Within a reasonable time after the occurrence of such event but no later than ten (10) calendar days, the Party whose obligations are affected (the "Affected Party") thereby shall notify the other in writing stating the nature of the event and the anticipated duration. The Affected Party's obligations under this Agreement shall be suspended during the continuance of any delay or inability caused by the event, but for no longer period. The Affected Party shall further endeavor to remove or overcome such delay or inability as soon as is reasonably possible.

For purposes of this Agreement, a Force Majeure Event includes, but is not limited to: strikes or other labor disputes, severe weather disruptions, natural disasters, fire or other acts of God; riots, war, or other emergencies; failure of any governmental agency to act in a timely manner; the discovery of any hazardous substance or differing and unforeseeable site conditions; and any other incapacities of any Party, similar to those enumerated, which are not within the control of the Party claiming such inability, which such Party could not have avoided by the reasonable exercise of due diligence and care.

20. **Assignment.** Brodart may not assign this Agreement to another party without the prior written consent of County.
21. **Successors and Assigns Bound.** County and Brodart each bind themselves and their successors and assigns to the other Party and to the successors and assigns of such other Party, with respect to all covenants of this Agreement.
22. **Publicity.** Contact with citizens of Fort Bend County, media outlets, or other governmental agencies shall be the sole responsibility of County. Under no circumstances, whatsoever, shall Brodart release any material or information developed

or received during the performance of Services hereunder unless Brodart obtains the express written approval of County or is required to do so by law.

23. **Notice.** Any and all notices required or permitted under this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, or personally delivered to the following addresses:

Within ten (10) calendar days of the Effective Date of this Agreement, Brodart shall designate in writing a representative to be County's primary contact during the term of this Agreement and such representative shall be available as required for the benefit of the Services and County.

24. **Performance Representation.** Brodart represents to County that Brodart has the skill and knowledge ordinarily possess by well-informed members of its trade or profession practicing in the greater Houston metropolitan area and Brodart will apply that skill and knowledge with care and diligence to ensure that the Services provided hereunder will be performed and delivered in accordance with the highest professional standards. Brodart warrants that the Services will be free from material errors and will materially conform to all requirements and specifications contained in the attached Exhibits.
25. **Entire Agreement and Modification.** This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the Parties and supersedes all previous agreements, written or oral, pertaining to the subject matter of this Agreement. Unless specifically provided in this Agreement, any change to the terms of this Agreement, Scope of Work for the Project, or any attached Exhibits shall be in writing and signed by each Party. **IT IS ACKNOWLEDGED BY BRODART THAT NO OFFICER, AGENT EMPLOYEE, OR REPRESENTATIVE OF COUNTY HAS ANY AUTHORITY TO CHANGE THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY ATTACHED EXHIBITS THERETO UNLESS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY THE FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT.**

26. **Understanding Fair Construction.** By execution of this Agreement, the Parties acknowledge that they have read and understood each provision, term, and obligation contained herein. This Agreement, although drawn by one party, shall be construed fairly and reasonably and not more strictly against the drafting Party than the non-drafting Party.
27. **Severability.** In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.
28. **No Waiver of Immunity.** Neither the execution of this Agreement nor any other conduct of either party relating to this Agreement shall be considered a waiver or surrender by County of its governmental powers or immunity under the Texas Constitution or the laws of the state of Texas.
29. **Conflict.** In the event of any conflict or inconsistency among the terms and conditions set forth in the documents comprising this Agreement, the order of priority will be: (1) Texas State Contract 715-M2; (2) this Agreement; (3) Brodart's Brodart's Pricing Proposal, dated December 22, 2025 (attached hereto as Exhibit A); and (4) Contract Item List (attached hereto as Exhibit B).
30. **Applicable Law and Venue.** This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the state of Texas. Venue for any claim arising out of or relating to the subject matter of this Agreement shall lie in a court of competent jurisdiction of Fort Bend County, Texas. County does not agree to submit disputes arising out of the Agreement to binding arbitration. County does not agree to pay any and/or all attorney fees incurred by Brodart in any way associated with the Agreement.
31. **Certain State Law Requirements for Contracts** The contents of this Section are required by Texas law and are included by County regardless of content For purposes of Sections 2252.152, 2271.002, and 2274.002, Texas Government Code, as amended, Brodart hereby verifies that Brodart and any parent company, wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, and affiliate:
- (a) Unless affirmatively declared by the United States government to be excluded from its federal sanctions regime relating to Sudan or Iran or any federal sanctions regime relating to a foreign terrorist organization, is not identified on a list prepared and maintained by the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts under Section 806.051, 807.051, or 2252.153 of the Texas Government Code.

- (b) If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Brodart does not boycott Israel and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott Israel during the term of such contracts. "Boycott Israel" has the meaning provided in § 808.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- (c) If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Brodart does not boycott energy companies and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to boycott energy companies during the term of such contracts. "Boycott energy company" has the meaning provided in § 809.001 of the Texas Government Code.
- (d) If employing ten (10) or more full-time employees and this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Brodart does not have a practice, policy, guidance, or directive that discriminates against a firearm entity or firearm trade association and is authorized to agree in such contracts not to discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association during the term of such contracts. "Discriminate against a firearm entity or firearm trade association" has the meaning provided in § 2274.001(3) of the Texas Government Code. "Firearm entity" and "firearm trade association" have the meanings provided in § 2274.001(6) and (7) of the Texas Government Code.

- 32. **Human Trafficking.** BY ACCEPTANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT, BRODART ACKNOWLEDGES THAT FORT BEND COUNTY IS OPPOSED TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND THAT NO COUNTY FUNDS WILL BE USED IN SUPPORT OF SERVICES OR ACTIVITIES THAT VIOLATE HUMAN TRAFFICKING LAWS.
- 33. **Captions.** The section captions used in this Agreement are for convenience of reference only and do not affect the interpretation or construction of the Agreement.
- 34. **Electronic and Digital Signatures.** The Parties to this Agreement agree that any electronic and/or digital signatures of the Parties included in this Agreement are intended to authenticate this writing and shall have the same force and effect as the use of manual signatures.
- 35. **Certification.** By his or her signature below, each signatory individual certifies that he or she is the properly authorized person or officer of the applicable Party hereto and has the requisite authority necessary to execute this Agreement on behalf of such Party, and each Party hereby certifies to the other that it has obtained the appropriate approvals or authorizations from its governing body as required by law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, and intending to be legally bound, County and Brodart hereto have executed this Agreement to be effective on the date signed by the last Party hereto.

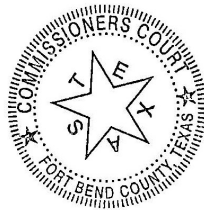

The discounts and terms offered herein are from the State of Texas Contract #715-M2, Cooperative Purchase Agreement, based on the annual spend of \$313,500 for the library's fiscal year 2026.


